Self-management for patients with progressive incurable diseases is not a matter of course. Their progressive physical and/or cognitive decline may often mean that self-management skills

are limited. Self-management support by nurses can strengthen these skills and is therefore of paramount importance. In addition, nurses' can support the self-management of family carers, who have to cope with the problems of the patient as well as with their own problems.
